



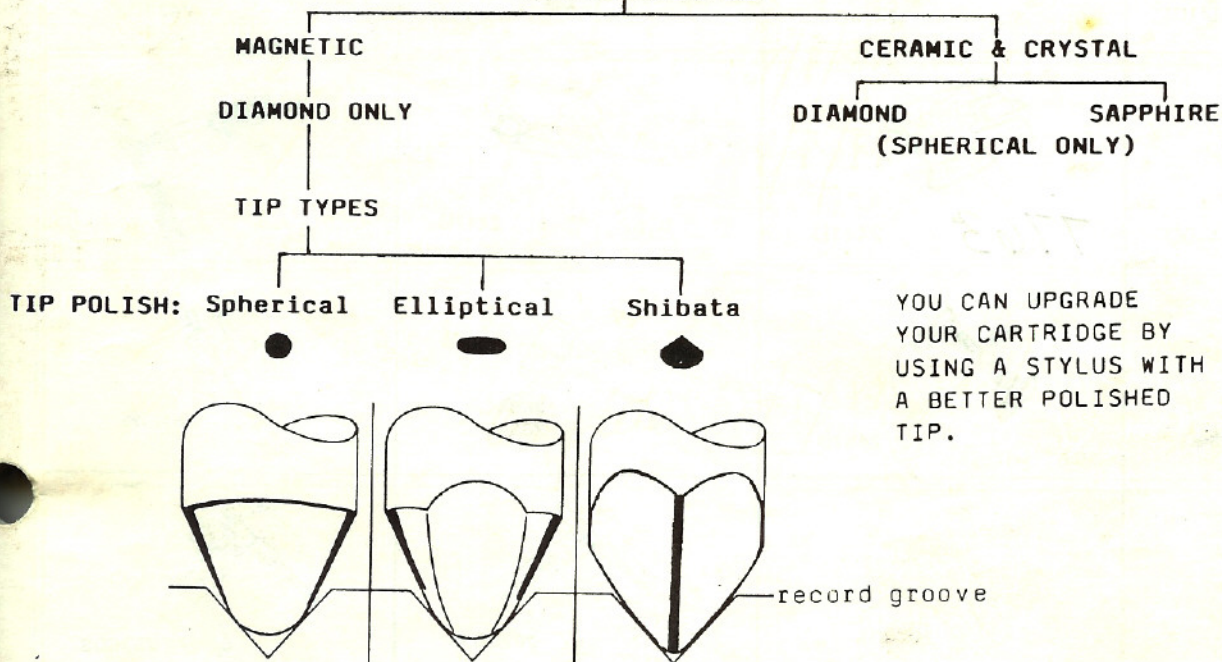

The most important part of the sound reproduction system is the stylus tip assembly. This is why we have used highest quality parts unsparingly to produce the "PRO MAG " series of needles. The four major causes of record wear by a phonograph stylus are: Stylus Force, Effective Tip Mass, Stylus Tip Shape and Stylus Tip Polish. Each of these causes has been minimized in EVG's "PRO MAG " Series of replacement needles.

HOW TO FIND:

CERAMIC NEEDLES

Step 1-Try to match your old needle with the pictures on pages 3 & 4.

Step 2-Use the CARTRIDGE manufacture's part number listed alphabetically in the text.

NOTE: In many cases single tipped needles have been replaced with double tipped (flip over) needles. As a rule, if the needle fits it usually works.

HOW TO FIND:

MAGNETIC STYLII

Step 1-Try and match your old stylii with the full size pictures found on both covers.

The actual color may vary, it's the physical size that's important. When a match is made, go to the "FIGURE NUMBER" index on pages 5 thru 10 for the EVG part number. At this point you can go to the text for a different view of the stylii. The figure numbers in the text coincide with the numbers on the cover.

Step 2-If you know the CARTRIDGE manufacture's name(and part number) look it up alphabetically, pages 17 thru 86 .

PRO-MAG replacement styli are the product of EVG and are not to be deemed made by the original cartridge manufacturers except where indicated on the stylus.
